In its context **Psalm 118:24 is Messianic**. The author composed this psalm to be sung by the crowds approaching the temple during great worship festivals in Jerusalem; and **this is the song the children sang as Jesus entered Jerusalem on Palm Sunday**. He is the stone, rejected by the builders, who became the cornerstone (vv. 22–24).

has become the capstone;**
²³ **the LORD has done this,
and it is marvelous in our eyes.**
²⁴ **This is the day the LORD has made;
let us rejoice and be glad in it.**

I will be his father, and he shall be my son” (2 Sam. 7:14). **The New Testament repeatedly affirms that Jesus was “the son of David” (Matt. 1:1). Jesus himself claimed to be “the son of David” (Matt. 22:42–45). The Palm Sunday crowd also hailed Christ as “the son of David” (Matt. 21:9).**
