- A. The power of His resurrection. **The resurrection gives hope to all of life.**
- B. The fellowship of His sufferings. To share in the sufferings of Christ is not a penalty, but a privilege (1 Peter 4:12, 13; 2 Timothy 3:12).

According to Hebrews, by God's raising of Jesus from the dead, men and women are freed from the bondage caused by the fear of death (Heb. 2:14–15; 13:20). All face death (9:27), but **God's promise of resurrection gives hope that one's relationship with him will be renewed on the final day** (Heb. 12:22–24; see 11:19).

The key saying on Christ and the resurrection is 11:25, the primary reference of which is to future resurrection, though it covers also present resurrection; Christ as the **Resurrection gives hope** for the **future life**, and the reality of that **life in the present**.
