This is the part of Christian morals most sharply different from other moral systems. There is one vice everyone has, yet everybody loathes in others. Lewis had never heard anyone who is not a Christian “accuse himself” of this defect. No fault makes a person more unpopular, and yet there is no fault of which we are more unconscious. The more we are guilty of it, the more we hate it in others. What is it? Pride or self-conceit.
