1854 HUDSON TAYLOR ARRIVES IN CHINA

From the age of five, James Hudson Taylor (1832–1905) ***desired to be a missionary*** to China. Although chronic health problems almost derailed his dream, he fulfilled his goal when he arrived in Shanghai in 1854. Taylor soon began making evangelistic excursions into inland China in spite of the danger resulting from political unrest and mistrust of foreigners. Much of his success was due to his adoption of native dress and his facility with the language.

When the interior of China was opened to Westerners in 1865, Taylor founded the China Inland Mission.

He was sent to receive the Gentiles at Antioch (11:19–24). “The ministry of encouragement” calls Christians today. Young people need a Barnabas to encourage them. New converts need a Barnabas to strengthen them. Preachers, teachers, and ***missionaries need a Barnabas to stand by them.***
