## Quotes for the Week

God fulfills His conditional promises only after we meet certain obligations. If we don't meet the conditions, God is not obligated to fulfill those promises. For example, John 15:7 says, *"If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you."* This promise guarantees that God will answer our prayers only if ***Christ's words remain in us and we remain in Christ.***

The follower of Jesus must learn that like a branch on a vine, he can be fruitful only as he "remains" in Christ. *"Apart from me,"* Jesus insists, *"you can do nothing"* (15:5). The believer who remains in the true vine is accorded the promise of effective prayer: ***"If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you"*** (15:7). This is to the Father's glory. The thought is an echo of Jesus' earlier teaching in the Farewell Discourse (cf. 14:13f.).
