In view, then, of the certainty of the resurrection and the fact that faith in Christ is not in vain, the Apostle Paul exhorts his beloved brethren to be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that their labor is not in vain in the Lord. The truth of **resurrection changes** everything. It provides hope and steadfastness, and enables us to go on in the face of overwhelming and difficult circumstances.

The **resurrection** of Jesus Christ changes everything. It is the best possible news for human beings who live in a broken world and who enter that world separated from God because of their sin. In fact, the resurrection of Jesus Christ is one of his two massive accomplishments that together form the gospel or “good news.” The apostle Paul makes this claim in the New Testament letter we identify as 1 Corinthians. He says that this gospel that saves people—the gospel that they received and believed, the gospel that he delivered to them as of first importance—consists of two elements (1 Cor. 15:3–4): “that Christ died for our sins” and “that he was raised on the third day”.....Ironically, we often pay less attention to the **resurrection** than to the death of Christ. We glory in the cross of Christ, as we should (Gal. 6:14). But we give scant attention to the **resurrection** until Easter Sunday approaches. Mathewson, S. D., & Blomberg, C.
