Jesus warned His followers of persecution, even to the point of death.

Even so, **we are called to remain faithful.**

Consider the words of Bishop Ding, who headed the Three-Self Patriotic Movement of Protestant churches in China, which is the government-approved church in mainland China. He was speaking to a group of us who had the privilege of visiting with him in China back in 1984. We had no idea where he stood theologically because he was the government's approved representative to the churches. But he told us, "I know you are evangelicals; I know what you believe. If you were to travel the length and breadth of China you would find Christians who believe what you do...persecution wiped out theological liberalism in China."
