For example, he says Christians give a good testimony of their commitment to the Lord by their submission to government authorities (1 Peter 2:13-17). We may not agree with all the policies of our government, but God nevertheless calls us to be submissive—just as the apostles were **submissive to pagan Roman emperors**.
