Quotes for the Week

The responsibility of the husband is headship; that is, giving leadership to his wife and children. He should not do this, however, without consulting his wife and serving her and his children. He is responsible for all decisions affecting the direction and care of the home. To exercise leadership does not imply that he must always get his own way. It does mean that he should take the good of the family into account in the decisions that are made.

The role of the wife is submission to her husband's leadership. The Greek word is *hupotasso*, which literally means "to get under the burden of" someone. A wife should get under the burden of her husband, to make choices that affirm her husband as the leader. She understands his goals and aspirations and commits herself to seeing them fulfilled.

In a word, *hupotasso* means submission.
