Rebuilding the temple:—

THE FIRST THING THEY DID WAS TO **REBUILD THE ALTAR**. This was a right beginning. The altar of sacrifice was the centre of the Jewish religion; just as its antitype, the Cross, is the centre of Christianity. The Cross is our altar; it stands at the centre of our religion.

We note too that Elijah had to **rebuild the altar** with twelve stones representing each tribe of Israel. There had been an altar to the true God here, but it had been torn down in the persecution of Jehovah-worship by the followers of Baal. (See 19:10, 14.) So low had Israel sunk—and so remote seemed the chances for Elijah as the lone contender against a “successful” religion with its 450 prophets. But Elijah was not alone. The rebuilt altar was consecrated “in the name of the Lord.” For the Lord of unlimited power it would be an easy matter to gain the victory, using Elijah as his instrument.
