The promise of the Holy Spirit was not only to the first converts; but, as Peter, addressing them, said, “to us, and to our children, and to all that are afar off, even to as many as the Lord our God shall call.” However distant from that spot in Jerusalem, and however distant from that moment of time, the call might sound, it would carry with it the PROMISE; even that promise, the fulfilment of which made the early Church **so holy and so victorious**.

The promise of the Holy Spirit to the disciples was in a very marked way the “Promise of the Father,” but it was only realized after many days of *continued* and *importunate praying*. The promise was **clear** and **definite** that the disciples should be endued with power from on high, but as a condition of receiving that power of the Holy Spirit, they were instructed to “tarry in the city of Jerusalem till ye be endued with power from on high.” The fulfillment of the promise depended upon the “tarrying.” The promise of this “endowment of power” was made sure by **prayer**. Prayer sealed it to glorious results.
