Those that show respect have usually respect shown to them. As Jacob was **civil** to these strangers, so he found them **civil** to him. When he undertook to teach them how to despatch their business (v. 7), they did not bid him *meddle with his own concerns* and left them alone; but, though he was a stranger, they gave him the reason of their delay, v. 8. **Those that are neighbourly and friendly shall have neighbourly and friendly usage.**
