God commanded us to love Him and our brothers, not just Him (4:21). The first part of 5:1 is one of the clearest statements in Scripture of what a person has to believe to be saved. We must believe that Jesus of Nazareth is “the Christ” (the Anointed One whom God promised to provide as a substitute sacrifice for the sins of the world). Genuine love for God will result in obedience to His commandments. The fundamental proof of **love for God and people** is obedience to the Word of God (5:3). God’s commands are not burdensome (oppressive) because every believer has already exercised the faith in God that is essential for obedience and we love Him.
