God indicates that hospitality, or a spirit of selflessness, ought to mark the horizontal relationships in the church. Biblical hospitality, or welcoming others in an authentic way, begins with **a servant's heart**. Keep in mind that when you serve or welcome people who are likely to do things for you in return, that's called a business deal. That's not true, biblical hospitality. It's a win-win deal. But when you do something for someone else and expect nothing in return, that's the kind of hospitality that the apostle Paul says we are to be about.
