It is a pity that so few Christians know what they possess before God. They do not realize what they are worth so they do not enjoy full lives as Christians. Though they know they are Christians, they do not realize how well God saved them. But God put the Bible in our hands and His Spirit in our hearts. So that we might learn our position in Christ, and live in power and fullness. Many people have come to Christ but do not have **an assurance of salvation**. The Devil has short-changed them.

All Christians have the same sized Savior (John 1:12, 16). We do not receive Christ on the instalment plan. We do not receive a little of Him now and a little later. If we received Christ, we received the complete Christ. The issue is not getting more of Christ; the issue is allowing Him to get more of us.

The first thing a young convert needs is an understanding of what has actually taken place, coupled with **an assurance of salvation**. Here another warning is needed. Never tell one who has just professed faith in Christ that he is saved. Let the Holy Spirit tell him that, through the Word, and then let him tell you. Any assurance which the Christian worker gives will evaporate with the first temptation, but the witness of the Spirit will abide. We, however, may turn the new Christian to the great assurance passages, such as I John 5:10-13, and let the Holy Spirit speak to him through them.
