...James 1:19–2:26, which deals with the issue of **true faith**—a most important consideration indeed. Knowing your faith is genuine is a wonderful assurance, but thinking you’re saved when you’re not is the most frightening deception imaginable. In Matthew 7:21–23 Jesus speaks of those who call Him Lord and even do miracles in His name but aren’t redeemed. Second Timothy 3:5 speaks of those who have “a form of godliness” but deny its power. They’re religious but lost. Sadly, many people today are victims of the same deception. They think they’re Christians, but they’re heading for eternal damnation unless they recognize their true condition and repent.

Perhaps, you will say, “Why does the Lord make them (testing’s) so plentiful? Could he not have kept us from temptation?” There is no doubt he could, but it was never the Master’s intention that we should all be hothouse plants. He taught us to pray, “Lead us not into temptation,” but, at the same time, he does lead us there, and intends to do it, and this for the proving of our faith, to see whether it be **true faith** or not. Depend upon it, faith that is never tried is not **true faith**. It must be sooner or later exercised. God does not create useless things: he intends that the faith he gives should have its test, should glorify his name. These opportunities to return are meant to try your faith, and they are sent to you to prove that you are a volunteer soldier






